Palihouse Holloway is a boutique urban lodge offering 36 studio, one- and two-bedroom guest residences, a roof deck for private entertaining and The Hall, which includes a courtyard brasserie, espresso bar tabac and intimate lobby lounge. Offering the atmosphere of a stylish metropolitan hotel infused with timeless traditions and personal service, Palihouse Holloway invites you to make yourself at home for 7 nights or more.

## Location:

Palihouse Holloway is located in the heart of West Hollywood, a vibrant, dynamic city known as one of Los Angeles' most popular destinations for its entertainment venues and unparalleled nightlife and shopping. A center of progressive and trend-setting design, West Hollywood is home to the West Coast's leading resources of interior design, the Pacific Design Center and the Avenues of Arts & Design.

Located at the northwest corner of Holloway Drive and Hacienda Place, between Santa Monica Boulevard and the world-famous Sunset Strip, Palihouse Holloway is easily accessed from the 101 and 10 freeways. Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) and Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport (BUR) are within 12 miles. Private and charter aircraft guests are within easy reach of Santa Monica Airport (SMO), 10 miles, and Van Nuys Airport (VNO), 15 miles.

**The Hall:**

*Courtyard brasserie*

Traditional brasserie fare is served al fresco on a leafy, brick-lined patio alongside an enclosed dining room offset by floor-to-ceiling sliding glass doors. A neighborhood gathering place, The Hall's menu features Southern French Provençal classics such as steak frites Béarnaise, salade Niçoise, croque monsieur and plateaux de fruits de mer. An American hamburger is given a French accent with tomates farcies and a touch of herb aioli. Mediterranean ingredients including thyme, rosemary, juniper, garlic and olive oil enhance our dishes. Guests may also enjoy sipping a great glass of Rosé or unique signature cocktails.

Open daily for breakfast, lunch and dinner and for weekend brunch, The Hall brasserie is also available for private events, from intimate gatherings to spirited fêtes up to 100 people utilizing both indoor and outdoor space.

*Espresso bar tabac*

A neighborhood stopover—a place locals and guests alike drop in for the morning newspaper and coffee or an afternoon pick-me-up—featuring a unique selection of snacks, periodicals and other sundries.

*Lobby lounge*

Reminiscent of a living room that might have belonged to an eccentric, well-traveled relative with a penchant for collecting vintage, one-of-a-kind furnishings and art. The Moroccan tile floor, distressed leathers, dark walnut staircase and industrial loft accents impress with a Bohemian flair for the unexpected. Tableside bar service offers classic cocktails made-to-order using fresh ingredients and boutique spirits. The lounge accommodates up to 50 people and is perfect for social gatherings and cocktail parties.

**The Rooftop:**

Available exclusively for special events, the Palihouse Holloway rooftop offers a stylish, discreet entertainment venue for networking socials, engagement parties, product launches and more. For tastemakers, artists and business professionals seeking to host sophisticated events, the rooftop embraces the Old World European tradition of al fresco dining under the stars with exceptional, 360-degree views of West Hollywood and the Hollywood Hills. Banquets up to 45 people; receptions up to 100.

**Private Events:**

Palihouse Holloway's event team caters large social and corporate receptions, dinners and other events for up to 100 guests on the Rooftop and in The Hall respectively; smaller, more intimate events of 10-30 guests can be accommodated in select residences.

**Executive Chef:**

Executive Chef Stephanie O'Mary, 26, started her career as an apprentice for two years under Chef Todd English at Olives in New York City following her graduation from Columbia University and the French Culinary Institute. Stephanie then worked as a line cook under Michael White at Fiamma Osteria, during which time the restaurant received a coveted 3-star rating in the New York Times. Stephanie was also involved in the opening of Vento Trattoria in New York's Meatpacking District. In the summer of 2005 Stephanie relocated to Los Angeles, where she served as Chef de Cuisine of Dakota Restaurant at the historic Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel. Young, dedicated, and talented, O'Mary is responsible for all kitchen operations and menu creation at Palihouse Holloway, as well as in-residence dining and catered events.
